I personally had the privilege to officially be responsible as a board member in charge of membership in naming the West Maui Taxpayers Association Inc., (WMTA) from the Honokowai-Napili-Kapalua Taxpayers Union, (HNKTU), in 1980 and accordingly, this year marks the 35th anniversary of the existence of the WMTA.

Some of the projects the community desired which the WMTA has been a part of the past 35 years had been declared impossible before they were done. i.e. The building of our Napili Fire and Ambulance Station with Private Funds, Fee Simple conversions of Condominiums from Leasehold, Lahaina By-Pass, An aquatic center, Senior Center, straightening Lower Honoapiilani Road at "S Turns and adding a park there, a Skate park in Lahaina town, and testifying to the State of Hawaii on behalf of the developer in obtaining a Certificate of Need for a West Maui Hospital are amongst those most notable.

Your volunteer board of directors have been operating the WMTA without the benefit of an Executive Director the past 4 years thanks to God and sharing costs with other organizations with the same interests. Without the benefit of cost sharing the WMTA would have been forced to close its operations! Unfortunately, that's what may happen without your immediate attention and assistance.

This is an urgent call to action! The WMTA has not been able to maintain meeting its meager annual budget under \$26 k, and pay its share of rent, utilities, and office expenses. We are at a turning point at this time. It has been said that "the importance of the WMTA cannot be overstated." I hope you agree and will evidence it by your making a year-end donation to the WMTA today. Time is of the essence. My report is not specific to West Maui but it will affect everyone reading this newsletter in a positive way.....

currently there is a two phase construction project underway in and around the airport.....the Kahului Access Road and the Airport Loop Road......

this will go a long way in having both residents and visitors avoid the Dairy Road/Hana Highway intersection, the busiest in the County......

the first phase of the project is scheduled to be completed in March of 2015 and the second phase by January of 2016.....

when both phases are completed you will be able to access the airport without going through that intersection if you so choose......you will also be able to go to Costco without going through that intersection also......

so, it's about a 13 month project from December 1st.....and certainly will be transformative for Maui County and for all Maui residents.....

and, FYI, all the rental car facilities will be moving to a new location as part of this project and resurfacing and upgrading the runways will also be happening.....

WMTA GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- 1) Promote the development and construction of a critical access medical facility in West Maui with associated facilities.
- 2) Support emergency preparedness programs for West Maui.
- 3) Support budget requests for MEO projects and improved police and fire fighting facilities in West Maui.

EDUCATION

1) Lobby for funding for the Lahaina Complex After School Tutoring Program.

TRAFFIC AND ROADWAYS

- 1) Promote the completion of the Lahaina Bypass and other traffic mitigation projects in West Maui. Support design and construction of alternative roadways to reduce traffic on Honoapiilani Highway (ie Kahua Street).
- 2) Pursue completion of the upgrades and paving of lower Honoapiilani Road from Kahana to Napili
- Promote improvements to Honoapiilani Highway from the Pali to Lahaina Town to protect the single access in and out of West Maui.
- 4) Spur County to complete Shaw Street sidewalk from Front Street to Honoapiilani Highway as promised.
- 5) Promote implementation of the Maui County Complete Streets Ordinance on all West Maui projects, especially pedestrian safety improvements at the Front Street/Fleming Road and Honoapiilani Highway intersection.
- 6) Support expansion and improvement of County public transit service in West Maui.
- 7) Support moving the southern terminus of the Lahaina Bypass to Cut Mountain.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- Continue to support well planned housing projects in West Maui that include both affordable and work force elements. (ie: Wainee Village, Kaanapali 2020, Kohoma Stream infill, Villages at Leiallii, Puukolii Village Mauka, Pulelehua, 'Kahoma Village, etc.)
- 2) Support the expansion of the Ka Hale A Ke Ola Homeless Resource Center to address the homeless encampment problems in West Maui.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- 1) Press for improvements to the pump station at Honoapiilani Highway and Ka'anapali Parkway to address the sewer odor problem.
- Pursue funding for improvements to the Honokowai sewage treatment plant, including completion of the ultraviolet canal, to provide treatment, storage and distribution systems to reuse treated waste water instead of using injection wells, and to address odor problems.
- 3) Support the operation/preservation of the new West Maui skate park.
- 4) Support development of an off-highway bicycle greenway for West Maui.
- 5) Urge the County to aggressively develop under-utilized water resources to ensure adequate supply for current and future needs
- 6) Support purchase of land at Makila for the development of a new county shoreline park from Launiupoko to Cut Mountain
- 7) Urge completion and promotion of a shoreline walkway from 505 Front Street to Honokowai.

VOTER/TAXPAYER REPRESENTATION

- 1) Represent taxpayers in the budgeting process, with an emphasis on right-sizing government and greater efficiency in government programs.
- 2) Support effort to reform the permitting process and change the Planning Department focus more to customer service with fewer bureaucratic hurdles and a less expensive permitting process.
- 3) Promote business friendly regulatory and tax policies for enhanced job creation, especially in the hospitality industry.
- 4) Support fairness and certainty in real property taxation.
- 5) Support the effort to bring fairness and true voter representation to the Maui County election process for Council seats.
- 6) Promote communication between West Maui taxpayers and their government with the annual WMTA meetings, the WMTA Candidates Night (the only such forum on the West side), and aggressive get-out-the-vote efforts.
- 7) Build awareness of West Maui harbor needs and support harbor area revitalization.

CULTURAL PROTECTION

- 1) Preserve and promote Hawaiian cultural efforts, such as:
 - a. Support the efforts of the Royal Hawaiian Guard and its efforts with Na Kia'i O Wainee to honor the monarchs at Wai Ola Cemetery.
 - b. Support funding for the Lahaina Honolua Senior Citizens Club.
 - c. Support the creation of a new cemetery in West Maui
 - d. Support restoration of Moku'ula
