Hawaii's governor Ige has recently amended pre-travel testing requirements for transpacific arrivals for everyone into the state of Hawaii. (Please check with specific islands for date of travel, as well as the State site, as things change often and fast).

The picture to the left, of new WMTA Board member and Rotary Club of Lahaina Board Member Dean Louie (left in photo) was recently featured in the Lahaina News with current WMTA Vice President, Joe Park.

Dean believes in higher education. He is a product of a traditional college education as well non-traditional pathways, undertaking a Chef's Apprenticeship in San Francisco and earning a Master's degree in Library and Information Science through distance-learning platforms.

As the new coordinator of the Lahaina Education Center, his role supports students in their academic journey, whether they are pursuing an academic degree, entering trade apprenticeships, seeking quick workforce development training, or desire leisure, fitness or career exploration classes.

The Lahaina Education Center is an extension of the University of Hawaii Maui College (UHMC) that provides hands-on service supporting UHMC students and staff in West Maui. The outreach facility offers 2800 sq.ft. of classrooms, student study, and conference space, and was established in 2006 to reduce the lengthy 50-mile round-trip commute to the main Kahului campus from Central Lahaina for those seeking education and skills training for our Maui Industries.

In addition to supporting incoming UHMC students from our High Schools, they are actively looking for ways to partner with our West Maui community needing community space for classes, lessons, training, or civic events.

Lahaina Education Center Mission:

- Provide a clean, safe, comfortable location where West Maui students and commuters can get test proctoring, online tutorial assistance and use study areas.
- Offer access to WIFI/Internet, IT computer resources and printing services for faculty and students for distance learning.
- Advance academic and non-credit partnerships and other support program staff to strategize learning assistance that help UHMC students and instructors reach their goals.
- Meet the academic needs of students, faculty, and the Maui community.

DENNIS TERPIN



Dennis was previously featured in WMTA Newsletters in conjunction with the WMTA Health and Safety Efforts to put in place an Emergency Plan for West Maui. Now, as a WMTA board member, Dr. Terpin will be leading the WMTA Emergency Planning committee moving forward into 2021.

Dennis serves as the Chief Operating Offer for the International Safety and Health Specialists, LLC and served on the AOAO Board of Directors at Aston Kaanapali Shores. Dennis Terpin is the Retired Senior Industrial Hygienist and Emergency Manager at The University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC). Dennis served as Deputy Commander of the University's Emergency Response Team and Safety Office for the University Incident Management Team. Some of the roles Dr. Terpin have

performed during his 50-year career in the occupational safety, health, laboratory safety, emergency management and response fields include World Trade Center 9/11 responder, safety manager, fire chief, paramedic, rescue specialist, and Homeland Security/FEMA certified instructor (CDP and EMI). Dr. Terpin serves on the ANSI Z88, Z88.10 and ASTM F23.65 International Respiratory Protection Committees.

Dr. Terpin is the recipient of the 2014, Illinois Emergency Management Agency-Emergency Management Achievement Award, the 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 - Gold Level DHS/FEMA/Center for Domestic Preparedness Excellence (in the indirect Training Program) Instructor awards and three Center for Domestic Preparedness 5.0 Perfect Instructor Awards.
