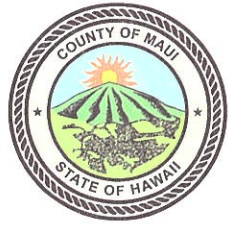

## Are you Recycling or Wish-Cycling?

Wish-Cycling is the practice of tossing questionable items in the recycling bin, hoping they can somehow be recycled. Wish-Cycling puts a strain on our recycling facilities because these items need to be hand-sorted out.

#### **PLASTIC BOTTLES**

- ♻️ **RINSED CLEAN**
- ♻️ **NO FRUIT OR FOOD CONTAINERS**
- ♻️ **NO PLASTIC BAGS**
- ♻️ **NO OTHER PLASTICS**

#### **ALUMINUM / BI-METAL**

- ♻️ **ALUMINUM AND BI-METAL CANS**
- ♻️ **RINSE CLEAN, DISCARD LIDS, LABELS OK**
- ♻️ **NO AEROSOL CANS OR PAINT CANS**
- ♻️ **NO FOOD RESIDUE**

#### **NEWSPAPER**

- ♻️ **ALL NEWSPAPERS INCLUDING INSERTS**
- ♻️ **REMOVE FROM PAPER OR PLASTIC BAGS**
- ♻️ **NO MAGAZINES OR OFFICE PAPER**
- ♻️ **NO PHONEBOOKS**

#### **CARDBOARD & PAPER BAGS**

- ♻️ **CORRUGATED BOXES, BOXBOARD, CARDBOARD ROLLS**
- ♻️ **PAPER EGG CARTONS, PAPER BAGS OF ALL COLORS**
- ♻️ **BREAK DOWN OR FLATTEN EVERY SIZE BOX**
- ♻️ **REMOVE ALL PLASTIC OR STYROFOAM**

**Glass: County Recycling Centers ONLY – not 3 Can Plan**

#### **GLASS CONTAINERS**

- ♻️ **BOTTLES, JARS OF ALL SIZES**
- ♻️ **RINSE CLEAN, DISCARD LIDS, LABELS OK**
- ♻️ **NO FOOD RESIDUE**
- ♻️ **NO CERAMICS, LIGHT BULBS, OR WINDOW**

## Waste Reduction Is Our Goal:

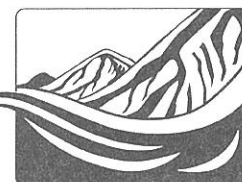
### Refuse, Reduce & Reuse!

The truth is, we can't recycle as many types of items as we could before. It is more important than ever to take personal responsibility in reducing our overall waste stream. *Everything you do makes a difference.*

## Waste Reduction Tips

- Make a plan and commit to a more waste-free lifestyle with your family
- Think before you buy; buy only what you need
- Refuse single-use plastics and other items by bringing your own bag, utensils, straw, coffee cup, water bottle, etc.
- Replace single-use items in your home with reusable, non-plastic options
- Choose options with less packaging when making purchases, especially plastic packaging
- Buy items in bulk rather than smaller quantities
- Fix broken items rather than buying new ones
- Consider buying used items instead of new, and donate rather than dispose
- Make a meal plan and store food wisely
- Request non-plastic filler when ordering online
