# Technical Advisory Committee & Stakeholder Visioning Sessions

Please join the project team for two days of hands-on sessions to frame a future vision for the West Maui Community Corridor. From affordable and workforce housing to multimodal transportation to economic development to sustainability and resiliency, **we'll cover all aspects of what it means to create a transit-oriented community corridor for West Maui.**

We'll begin our time together on the first day with walking audits of the three Transit-Oriented Community (TOC) sites identified in the West Maui Community Plan. Using the learnings from our walks, we'll shape a vision and focus on corridor-wide transportation and land use needs and opportunities. Our second day will identify specific programs, projects, and policies for the three TOC sites, digging into the details of implementation.

These sessions are open to the project's Technical Advisory Committee, invited stakeholders, and elected officials and complement the public events held throughout the week. Information developed in these sessions will be shared with the larger community during "office hours" and future community meetings.
